#### NEW BUSINESS:

#### HUMANITARIAN/COMMUNITY SUPPORT

-STCC Executive Officer Donn Weaver outlined several community service initiatives. The plan under the management of BMVC, of which STCC is a member, included NVHS, DAV, 2022 Stand Down to Stand Up, and Vets Emergency Relief Fund.

-Donn pointed out the visibility STCC and OCSAA would receive from participation.

-Tom Rozek then stepped up and said he would take lead for STCC to sponsor a golf hole in December 2022, a MOAA Good Deeds Foundation program which was similar in purpose to the organizations Donn suggested.

-Tom 's initiative received positive approval from the membership. Tom and Donn will work out program details for member dissemination.

#### CHAPTER ASSESSMENT

-Phil Kearns, SPO briefed a study he and the Commander developed, titled the "LIFE CYCLE OF AN OCS CHAPTER" It was based on one years provisional status of STCC. The basic premise was STCC operated with reduced participation and interest, thus operational alternatives were developed.

-The Commander then presented the alternatives and lead an open discussion concerning the "pros and cons".

-The membership voted unanimously to increase OPTEMPO including additional social events.

-The study will be provided to the OCSAA BOD to: 1) as an assessment of one years provisional status and 2) a tool to assist developing and existing Chapters with operations. The study is available to members on request.
